Kazimierz Series KSSM&AIAS

The Kazimierz Series is a dynamic joint project among SAIAD, KSSM and AIAS that aims to create consciousness about migration through the publication of the migration stories behind small entrepreneurs in Kraków.

The project has three stages of implementation that go from the selection, official logo's design, initial round of interviews and generation of questions in the first stage; the second stage with the final round of interviews and publication of the stories; and the last and third stage with the organisation of a networking event to connect the participants with the public and private sectors.

"Kazimierz" is a reference to the iconic Kazimierz III Wielki, who granted privileges and protections in favour of migrant Jewish communities, to settle in Poland.
